AGE/GRADE AT WHICH FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY TRANSFERS FROM ELEMENTARY DISTRICT TO THE HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

All financial responsibility will transfer for special education students from the elementary district to the high school district on the following schedules:

	<u>K-6 Districts</u>	<u>K-8 Districts</u>
Graded	When the student is promoted to the 7 th grade.	When the student is promoted to the 9 th grade.
Ungraded	When a student turns the age of 12 years, 6 months on or before September 1 st of the current school year.	When a student turns the age of 14 years, 6 months on or before September 1 st of the current school year.

Notwithstanding any provisions under the operating agreement between the charter school and the chartering district, a charter school that serves special education students is fiscally responsible for such students who enrolled in the charter school.

The elementary district is responsible for all costs associated with Extended School Year (ESY) for a student transferring from the elementary district to the high school district.

A consortium may choose to develop an alternative agreement to the SELPA policy for services provided within the consortium for its members.
